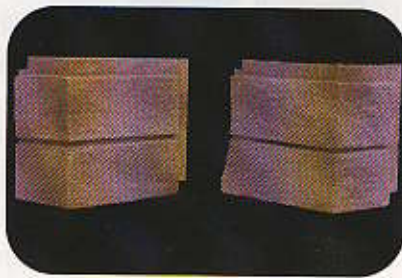

LIGHTWEIGHT POLYURETHANE PANELS THAT LOOK LIKE ROCK AND BRICK

Advanced Rock Technologies, Golden, CO, manufactures lightweight polyurethane panels suitable for interior and exterior use. The



panels are molded to take on the appearance of real rock and brick. Once installed, the panels are indistinguishable from stone and brick applied by skilled masons. The panels weigh less than one pound per square foot and because each panel covers several square feet, the overall cost and ease of installation is much less than that of traditional masonry products.

Advanced Rock Technologies uses state-of-the-art polyurethane chemistry. The company combines UV stabilizers, scratch resistant agents and additives to enhance the texture and feel of the surface. They also use oxide pigments that are applied to the mold prior to PU injection, making the longevity of the surface infinitely superior to traditional painted surfaces.

Currently there are two styles available – cut sandstone and tumbled brick. The company also manufactures a complete line of accessories, including ledgers, corners and touch-up pigment kits to enhance the installation.
